About Our Sessions

All our sessions will be at our Madison location (other than the Photo Walks) beginning at 9:30 a.m. Saturday and running about 60 minutes. Anyone 16 or older may attend. (We offer no babysitting service.) If you have a camera, please bring it with you. Make sure the batteries are charged and there is free space on your memory card. The cost of each lesson is in parentheses)

The cost of each session is \$15, payable at the time of registration. All registrations must be made no later than 48 hours before the day of the session. Refunds will be available for cancellations made at least 1 day in advance of the session.

If you are attending the photo walk, please assemble at Madison PhotoPlus or the Photo Summit 15 minutes before class.

For those attending a critique session, a \$5.00 credit to those submitting one or more photos to be presented.

•Saturday, April 7•

Basic Digital Photography (\$15)

Starting with how to hold your camera, the fundamentals are covered. Topics include memory cards, downloading your pictures, using your camera's flash, etc.

•Saturday, April 14•

Photographing Spring Outdoor Sports (\$15)

Primarily for baseball, soccer, lacrosse, field hockey, golf and track. Lens options and shooting techniques will be discussed.

•Saturday, April 21•

Interchangeable Lens Camera Basics: (\$15)

Things have changed since your last new camera, especially if this is your first SLR. This session is all about understanding what your new system camera does and how to make it do what YOU want. Whether your camera is a traditional DSLR or a Mirrorless camera, this session is designed to take the mysteries out of today's photographic tools.

•Saturday, April 28•

Photo Walks (\$10)
